#### GUEST SPEAKER: Steve Clemesha.

Steve spoke with us about how to display our plants to their best advantage. He suggested

- Remove dead growths and cup off black tips on leaves – these look more natural if cut at an angle
- Remove old black flower sheaths, but leave green ones
- Clean pots
- Remove old back bulbs from Cymbidiums
- Tie leaves away from flowers, but try to keep it looking natural
- Make sure plant is disease free, treat if necessary
- Stake up to flowers, but not above
- Judges look at flowers, not plants, but nice plants make a good impression

## 7. ORCHID SOCIETY SHIRTS

At the last meeting the members agreed to a new shirt as the official CHOS shirt since the other shirt is no longer in stock. We have chosen a darker blue in a better quality material.

The cost of this shirt is \$25 - \$28. It can be purchased from the embroidery shop at the Northside Shopping Centre. It is suggested that you check to see if he has a shirt in your size and if he doesn't he will order one for you. We have asked him to hold orders until 9<sup>th</sup> May so he can do a bulk order and hence reduce the prices for us. Once he has our shirts he will do the embroidery for us.

## 8. AUCTION

Kay Mitchell is having a sale and auction of many of her and Norm's prize plants before she leaves Bellingen and moves into town. This will happen on 20<sup>th</sup> April with sales starting at 10 am and the auction at 1 pm.
